NOTICE OF PREPARATION OF REGULATORY IMPACT STATEMENT

Proposed Motor Car Traders (Fees) Regulations 2018.

Notice is given in accordance with section 11 of the **Subordinate Legislation Act 1994** that a Regulatory Impact Statement (RIS) has been prepared for the Motor Car Traders (Fees) Regulations 2018.

The proposed Regulations, to be made under the **Motor Car Traders Act 1986**, would remake parts of the Motor Car Traders Regulations 2008.

The objective of the Motor Car Traders (Fees) Regulations 2018 is to prescribe licence fees and other fees under the Motor Car Traders Act 1986, to defray the cost of administering the licensing scheme for motor car traders under that Act.

The RIS examines the costs and benefits of the proposed Regulations and possible alternatives, and concludes that the proposed Regulations are the most efficient method of achieving the objective.
